

## **ACCESSIBILITY** Priority 2.1 Improvement and development of transport services and infrastructure



## Improving quality of transport infrastructure on the border area of Poland, Belarus and Ukraine

The project responds to the problems identified in the border regions of three countries, relating particularly low communication accessibility, poor quality of road infrastructure and inefficient transportation system. To reduce the impact of these negative factors a broad partnership was established involving Jabłoń Community, as a Lead Beneficiary together with partners from Poland, Belarus and Ukraine. The ImTraPBU project will modernise road sections crucial for the local development of all addressed areas. The overall objective of the project is an increase in communication accessibility of the partner communities but above that, all involved partners aim also at establishing effective channels of their contacts and cooperation.

Within the project, 7.91 km of new asphalt roads will be built and 11.58 km of road sections will be reconstructed. These road connections are important for the local and regional transport network in Jabłoń, Milanów, Rossosz, Sosnówka, Wisznice and Parczewski poviat in Poland and in the municipalities of Znamienka in Belarus and Zabrody in Ukraine. The execution of planned activities will reduce the travel time on the selected road sections by 30%. Project partners will also prepare a common strategy for the development of the transportation system.

Overall, the project will improve the quality of transport infrastructure and thanks to that - the quality of residents' life. It will increase the accessibility of the target regions and have a positive impact on communication in the border area. The project's expected long-term effects are the improvement of the investment conditions and enterprise growth.
